Pre-op instructions for TNR:

Submit an application to TNR.centralpahumane@gmail.com

After submitting an application, someone will be in contact to schedule surgery. If you need to rent a trap, we will schedule a trap pick up day.

TNR is a free program to the public in Blair County to get stray/feral cats spayed/neutered and their rabies vaccination. The program is financially maintained with donations and grants that we have to apply for. No owned pets can be a part of this program. See our Veterinary Services for a Spay Days form.

All feral cats must be brought in traps for their spay/ neuter surgery. We have the right to turn you away if this is not followed. It is for the safety of both the cats and the surgery personnel that we require all ferals to be in traps. Please bring a cat carrier to return your cat if using one of our traps.

We offer a 3-day trap rental for \$15 plus an additional \$30 deposit which is refundable upon return without damage. You may rent up to 3 traps at a time.

Once trapped, choose a place where the cat will be safe in its trap overnight. This should be a warm, dry, well-ventilated place. Covering the trap with a towel will allow the cat to remain quiet and comfortable. We do not recommend trapping in overly hot or cold temperatures due to risk to the cat.

Do not open the trap for any reason. A cat who escapes is rarely going to be caught again.

All cats must be brought to the CPHS wellness center at 8:30 AM on the scheduled date of surgery.

If a TNR cat has a medical issue that we have to treat, then that will be an added expense to the client. TNR covers the spay/ neuter, rabies vaccine, and ear tipping ONLY.

Any cat deemed to have a serious, untreatable medical condition that would make it inhumane to release it back to its colony, may be humanely euthanized at the discretion of the veterinarian. All pregnancies will be humanely terminated.

Post Op Instructions for TNR:

You will pick up the cat between 9am-2:00pm on the day of surgery. They will have received a pain medication and may be sleepy from anesthesia. Place the cat in a safe place for 24-48 hours before releasing back to the area in which they were trapped.

- All feral cats must be in traps when they come in for surgery.
- All cats must be returned to your property within 24-48 hours, unless there is an extenuating circumstance as to why the cat cannot be released. They must be released and the same location they were trapped.
- TNR can only be performed when weather is permitting.
- Any cat deemed to have a serious, untreatable medical condition that would make it inhumane to release it back to its colony, may be humanely euthanized at the discretion of the veterinarian. All pregnancies will be humanely terminated.
- I do hereby release the Central PA Humane Society (CPHS) of all claims against the CPHS and its entities affiliated with the foregoing from liability for any and all loss, damage, injuries, claims, demands, lawsuits, expenses and any other liability of any kind that may result from the CPHS representative performing the follow service that is requested below.
- All TNR cats will be ear tipped and you will be responsible for any extra charges due to illness or injury of the cats being trapped for TNR on your property that will need treatment at the time of surgery.
- There are additional services that you can request. Please see the attached form.
- I do hereby authorize the Central PA Humane Society to perform a procedure requiring anesthesia on these cat(s). I am aware of the risks involved and released the Central PA Humane Society, the contract veterinarians and their employees from any legal and financial responsibilities arising from anesthetic, surgical, or treatment complications.
