<p><u>Dog Walking</u> Our dogs would be grateful for a walk or a game of fetch. Give them exercise, practice walking them on a leash, and praise good behaviors. All these make them happier and ultimately more adoptable. An additional, one on one orientation with the volunteer administrator is required.</p>		
<p><u>Canine Cardio</u> Sign a dog out for a couple hours to take on a hike or go swimming. Out of the shelter environment can show you a different personality! This is very rewarding for the dogs.</p>		
<p><u>Cage Cleaning-Dogs</u> We provide clean cages daily all animals. Help us in the mornings with washing cages and setting up clean beds with blankets and food. This is an important task that will gratify you and the animals.</p>		
<p><u>Front Office/Phones</u> Our phone rings constantly. You'll be busy providing callers with information, taking messages, completing lost and found reports, and making copies. You won't know where the time went.</p>		
<p><u>Foster in Home-Cats</u> Provide a safe environment outside of the shelter for the animals who need time to recuperate in a quiet setting.</p>		
<p><u>Foster in home-Dogs</u> Provide a safe environment outside of the shelter for the animals who need time to recuperate in a quiet setting.</p>		
<p><u>Custodial/Yard Work</u> Assist us with keeping our property looking its best. Mow grass, shovel snow, sweep walks, wash windows, paint, clean plant beds, and more.</p>
